



Métairie Pinot Noir IGP Pays d'Oc Luc Pirlet vineyards

Located in the Languedoc-Roussillon wine region, this vineyard comes from a rigorous selection of 350 hectares of vines in an area stretching from Carcassonne to the Pyrenees foothills. Due to its amazing location, the vineyard benefits from the advantages of both Mediterranean and Atlantic climates, allowing the wines produced there to develop a good balance between fruitiness and acidity.



100% Pinot Noir



Minervois and Limoux regions, near the city of Carcassonne in the South of France. Soil: limestone and clay where Pinot Noir ripens fully. Vines : 25 years old - Yield : 3T per acre.



Traditional fermentation in stainless steel with a short fermentation; cap is punched down to help develop the grape's natural flavors.



Aging: Stainless steel vats.



Tasting Notes: Intense medium ruby color. Bouquet of blackcurrant, liquorice and cherries. Rich and pleasant palate.



Pairing: this wine accompanies perfectly roasted poultry, grilled tuna steak, duck, pasta with mushrooms, charcuterie, cheeses.



Enjoy now and for up to 5 years. Serve at 57-62F.
